After the meeting we discussed providing Foundation 61 with some 'Care Packs' for their women's program.

Caroline requested some specific items which she believed would be more beneficial to their clients, so we made up 20 packs consisting of a tooth brush, tooth paste, female deodorant, soap and a soap container, full size shampoo and conditioner, a woman's razor, nail clippers, a packet of pocket tissues and 50+ sunscreen. Each pack costing the club approximately \$22.00, with a total cost of \$434.40
